Context

The *Gulf Forum for Educational Researchers* serves as a pioneering platform aimed at enhancing scholarly communication and fostering constructive collaboration among educational researchers across the Gulf region. This initiative stems from a deep understanding of the vital role that scientific research plays in developing education and addressing emerging challenges facing educational systems in the region.

Organized by the Gulf Arab States Educational Research Center (GASERC), the forum comes at a critical juncture in the region's educational journey, marked by a growing need for innovative and effective solutions to improve the quality of education and strengthen learning outcomes. It aligns with the future visions of Gulf countries in achieving sustainable development and building thriving, knowledge-based societies.

Recognizing the central role played by educational researchers, this forum provides a unique space for scholarly engagement and professional exchange. It offers an opportunity to discuss key educational issues and challenges from a rigorous research perspective, explore the latest global research trends and methodologies, and benefit from successful regional and international experiences in education and educational research. This scientific gathering contributes to enriching the Gulf educational dialogue and promoting knowledge exchange, thereby helping shape clear visions for research priorities and educational needs across the region.

By organizing this significant two-day event, the forum aspires to become a platform for coordinating Gulf efforts in educational research and enhancing the capacities of Gulf researchers to support decision-makers in formulating sound, evidencebased educational policies that respond to the aspirations and development needs of Gulf societies. It also aims to serve as a genuine nucleus for a sustainable regional professional network that empowers researchers and strengthens their role in advancing education and development in the Gulf Arab States.
